Adding the DG information

When shipping Dangerous Goods, it's important you add the standard IATA SHC that reflects your shipment details:

SHC Description	Code
Diagnostic Specimens	RDS
Excepted Quantities of Dangerous Goods	REQ
Excepted Quantities of Radioactive Material	RRE
Lithium Ion Batteries otherwise excepted from the IATA DGR	ELI
Lithium Metal Batteries otherwise excepted from the IATA DGR	ELM
Corrosive	RCM
Cryogenic Liquids	RCL
Dangerous When Wet	RFW
Dry Ice	ICE
Fully Regulated Lithium Ion Batteries (Class 9)	RLI
Fully Regulated Lithium Metal Batteries (Class 9)	RLM

Flammable Gas	RFG
Flammable Liquid	RFL
Flammable Solid	RFS
Infectious Substance	RIS

Adding the DG information

For us to confirm your booking quickly, you must enter in the relevant DG information into the remarks section of the booking.

The details required include:

- Class
- UN Number
- Packing Instructions (PI)
- Packing Group (PG)
- Net Quantity (NQ)

We use these details to validate the booking, cross-checking out flight limits and capabilities.
